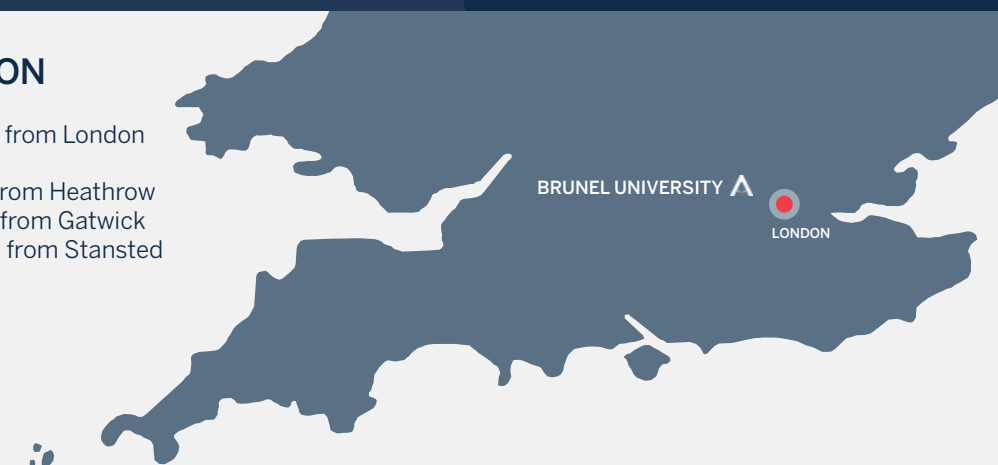
Brunel University, Uxbridge Campus is located in a suburb of Greater London at a green and secure university campus.
